Anand Ashram is a registered public trust, a Non-Government Organisation (NGO) committed to serve the community. The NGO aligns its charitable services with actual needs of society from time to time. Established in 2012, Anand Ashram has come a long way in various avenues of social services enumerated below:

Ashayein:

University Education fees to under-served girl students.

Sva-Shakti:

Vocational training Centre at village Undera for helping women to be self-reliant.

Vidya Sahayog:

Basic school material like school bags, stationery etc. are provided to under-served school children.

Senior Citizens Spiritual Sewa:

Our volunteers spend spiritual evenings with lonely seniors at Old Age Homes.

Jeevan Mulya:

Our Educators teach life-values to primary school children.

Planet Protectors:

Tree plantation programmes are organised during monsoon. Rain harvesting consultation is done by experts.

Vastradan:

Anand Ashram volunteers distribute good-conditioned clothes in various slum areas.

Raktdan:

Regular blood-donation camps are arranged.

Netradan:

To help eliminate corneal blindness in the country, pledge forms from eye donors are collected and submitted to Eye Bank.

Ration Kits Distribution:

Ration Kits are distributed to needy, especially during calamity/pandemic times.

Life Counselling:

Life counselling is provided to people having suicidal or depressive tendencies or having family issues.

Career Counselling:

Free career counselling is done for students by experts.

In India, the joint family system was once a common arrangement, where parents, grandparents, siblings, their spouses, and children all lived together under one roof. This setup provides senior citizens with the assurance of care and companionship as they aged.

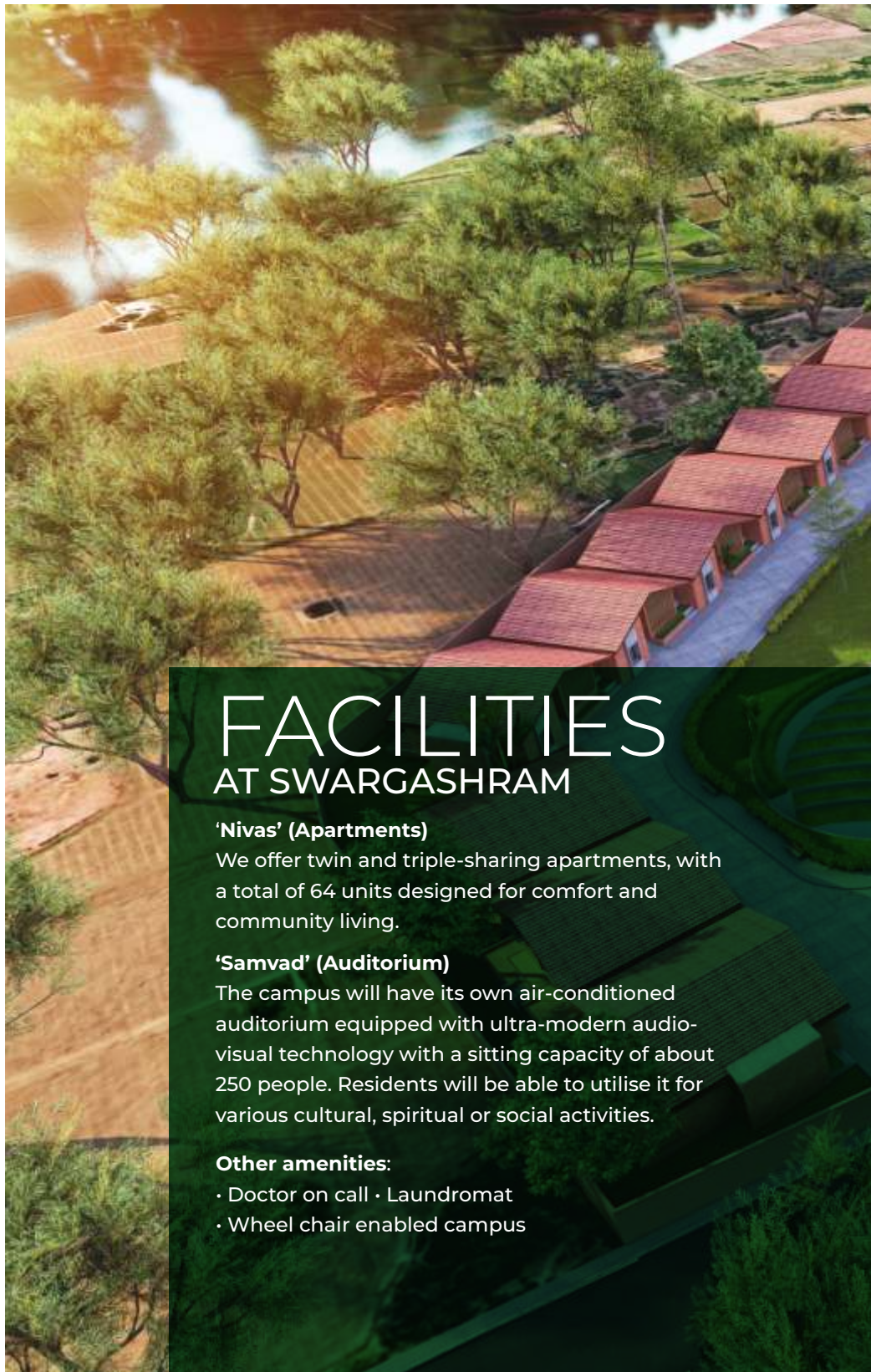

In a report titled 'Senior Care Reforms in India - Reimagining the senior care paradigm' NITI Ayog said a national portal for senior care must be developed for senior citizens to provide easy access of service to them.

The elderly 10% of the population, translating to about 104 million, and is projected to reach 19.5% of the total population by 2050. Population ageing is a global phenomenon and the number of people over 60 years of age has been rising rapidly across the world.

The report also called for earmarking CSR funds as a contribution to national funds for care provided to the non-affording category of the elderly in their facilities.

"We need to ensure the social security of the elderly and add more emphasis to well-being and care" NITI Ayog member Shri VK Paul said during the release of the report.

NITI Ayog Vice Chairman Suman Bery said it is time to start thinking about the special dimension of the senior care, in addition to medical and social aspects.

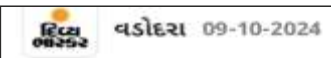
